BATTSETSEG Batmunkh, born on December 9, 1973, in Bayankhongor province, has served as the Minister for Foreign Affairs of Mongolia since 2021 January. She holds the distinction of being the third woman appointed to this position in Mongolia. Battsetseg is deeply committed to promoting gender equality and the empowerment of women and girls, with a particular focus on those residing in rural areas. In June 2023, she organized the Female Foreign Ministers' Meeting in Ulaanbaatar, marking the first occasion such a meeting took place in Asia.

Over a decade ago, Battsetseg launched the "Right-minded Mongolian" initiative, which has since evolved into a national campaign dedicated to fostering a love of learning among the younger generations. She is a devout Buddhist with a strong sense of cultural pride and awareness of her heritage. With her keen interest in the arts, she continues to support emerging singers, performers, and artists.
